## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DROP-OFF

Lafayette County residents now have two locations to take hazardous waste. The service is free to county residents. Lafayette County drop-off sites are in Concordia and Lexington. **Drop-offs are by appointment only.**

Concordia: To schedule an appointment call 660-463-2228. The drop-off day is every Thursday from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm.

Lexington: To schedule an appointment call 660-232-3827. The drop-off days are the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of the month.



## LOCATION OF TRASH CONTAINERS

Trash containers for use in one and two family dwellings should all be stored to the side or rear of the residence and may be placed at the curb NOT MORE THAN 24 HOURS prior to scheduled pickup.

## ODESSA RESERVOIR—A GREAT PLACE TO VISIT



If you have not been out to the Odessa Lake "Reservoir" lately, you might consider taking a trip out there. It is open from 6:00 am until 11:00 pm and is a great place to hike, boat, and fish. If you plan on fishing or boating, you must have a Missouri State Fishing license AND a City permit. The money received goes directly back to the upkeep and upgrades of the Lake. **(If you are under 16 or over 64 you do not need a fishing permit, but you still need a boating permit.)** Permits for fishing and boating at the city reservoir are sold at City Hall, Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 5:00 pm. You can also purchase them at the Odessa Police Department (816-633-7575) anytime, but you must bring exact change as the Police Department does not keep cash on hand.

Daily Fishing Permit is \$2.00 ~ Season Fishing Permit is \$8.00 ~ Season Boating Permit is \$8.00.

## PAYMENT OF UTILITY BILLS

Utility bills are due on the 15th of month to avoid a 5% penalty fee. All bills must be paid in full on or before 5:00 pm on the 20th of each month. If not paid, utilities will be disconnected without notice on the 21st. A fee of up to \$100 and the total bill will be due to reconnect service.

All bills are mailed as a courtesy, but failure to received a bill does not relieve the obligation to pay the bill when due. Please post payments early to ensure receipt, as we are not liable for the postal service.
