WHEN SNOW IS FORECAST

During a snow storm, City Crews will treat the streets with sand and salt. They will normally start around 6:00 a.m. on the morning of or the morning after the storm. The major streets of Main, Mason, Dryden, Johnson, Phillips, 1st, 3rd, N. 4th, S. 5th, and S. 9th Streets will be treated and plowed first. Other streets will be done as quickly as possible depending on the storm conditions.... PLEASE AVOID PARKING VEHICLES ON STREETS WHEN SNOW IS FORECAST

SIDEWALKS AND STOREFRONTS ~ It is important that business owners and residents keep the sidewalks in front of your businesses and homes cleared of snow and ice. Owners of vacant properties need to make sure those sidewalks are cleared as well. Please make sure there is a wide clear path for pedestrians and wheelchairs to safely travel. The entire length of your property should be cleared. Every year we have complaints from residents about the sidewalks in front of local businesses.
