Energy Assistance – LIHEAP

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) can help you pay your main heating and cooling bills. The program helps low-income people meet their immediate energy needs. To qualify for assistance, you must meet all of the following requirements:

- Be the person responsible for paying home heating and cooling costs
- Be a US citizen or have been legally admitted for permanent residence
- \$3,000 or less in bank accounts, retirement accounts, or investments
- Meet specific income guidelines that vary according to household size

Energy Assistance (EA) is a one-time payment for your primary heating source. Applications are accepted during the months of November through March. The Energy Crisis Intervention Program (ECIP) can help pay your fuel bills when your utilities are shut off or threatened to be shut off. Winter ECIP is available November through May based on funding with the maximum you could receive of \$800.

Dog tags for the 2020-2021 year are now available for purchase. All dogs within Odessa city limits are required to have a current city license. The cost is \$3.50 per tag. Please bring your dog's current rabies vaccination receipt with you to City Hall to purchase the license. Senior citizens 65 years of age or older are allowed one free tag. You will still need to bring a current rabies vaccination certificate for the dog.
