

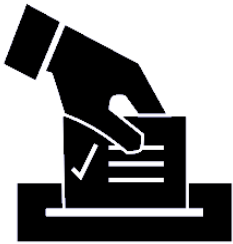

All dogs within Odessa city limits are required to be vaccinated against rabies and licensed with the city. The cost is \$3.50 per dog tag and is due on the first of October every year. Please bring your dog's rabies vaccination receipt to City Hall to purchase a tag.

## Restrictions on Outdoor Burning

The City of Odessa allows outdoor burning with restrictions. Outdoor burning is:

- ◆ NOT allowed on any street, alley, other thoroughfare, or public place.
- ◆ NOT allowed between sunset and sunrise.
- ◆ only allowed on private property.
- ◆ only allowed for organic materials that have not been chemically treated.

Please contact the Fire Department prior to burning at 816-633-7182 to ensure there isn't a burn ban in place.
