Labor Day Holiday

City Hall will be closed on Monday, September 6, for Labor Day. In addition, trash will not be picked up on that day and will be delayed that week by one day.

Upcoming Scheduled Electric Outage



We have been informed by Evergy that there is required maintenance needed in our substation. To conduct this maintenance a brief electrical outage for Odessa utility customers will be necessary. The outage will take place at night beginning the evening of Monday, September 6, at approximately 11:30 pm. The power should be restored within three hours (by 2:30 am Tuesday) barring any unforeseen issues. Please plan ahead for this outage regarding medical needs, electronics, etc.

Restrictions on Outdoor Burning

The City of Odessa allows outdoor burning with restrictions. Outdoor burning is:

- ◆ NOT allowed on any street, alley, thoroughfare, or public place.
- ◆ NOT allowed between sunset and sunrise.
- ◆ only allowed on private property.
- ◆ only allowed for organic materials that are not chemically treated.

Please contact the Fire Department prior to burning at 816-633-7182 to ensure there is no burn ban.

City Dog Tags

Dog tags are due October 1, 2021, and are valid from the date of purchase through September 30, 2022. All dogs within Odessa city limits are required to be licensed with the city and vaccinated against rabies. You may purchase city dog tags at City Hall for the 2021-2022 calendar year beginning October 1, 2021. The cost is \$6.60 per tag with those 65 years of age or older receiving their first dog tag free of charge. You must bring your dog's current rabies vaccination receipt to obtain a tag.

Per city ordinance, the maximum number of dogs/cats per residence is four. Dogs are not allowed to roam and must be on a leash or within a fenced yard when outside. Adequate food, water, and shelter must always be available for any dog kept outdoors. We also recommend that dogs and cats be spayed or neutered to help reduce overpopulation.

Farmers' Market Thursdays Through September

September is the last month for the Farmers' Market here in Odessa. Stop by and see local and regional vendors with their fresh produce, plants, baked goods, honey, and craft items for sale. Located at Railroad Park by the tracks on Hwy 131 just north of downtown every Thursday from 4-7 pm.

If recycling, please remember no glass, bags, napkins, styrofoam, or food waste may be included.



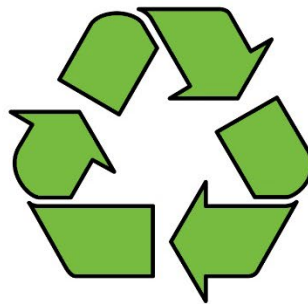
