City Fishing and Boating Permits

In addition to your fishing license, you must have a city permit to fish at the Odessa Reservoir. A one-day permit is \$2.00 or \$8.00 for the season. A season boating permit is an additional \$8.00. You may purchase permits at City Hall and the Odessa Police Department. Please bring exact change if purchasing at the Police Department. A city permit is not required to fish at Lake Venita at Dyer Park. If you have any questions, please contact City Hall at 816-230-5577.

Yard Waste Disposal

Now that Spring has finally sprung, yard work is starting up again. Please keep in mind that all premises and exterior property must be maintained free from weeds or plant growth in excess of 10 inches. Also, as you mow, please do not blow

your grass clippings into the street. During heavy rains, these grass clippings wash into our storm water system causing major interference with the proper operation of the system.

The City of Odessa has a dumpster for our citizens to use for yard waste located at 400 N First. This dumpster is not for commercial use and is ONLY to be used for vegetative debris including leaves, grass clippings, shrubs, hedge trimmings, weeds, brush, and branches. No plastic bags are allowed. If the dumpster is full, please do not leave yard waste around the dumpster on the ground.
