The annual election of officers of the City of Odessa will be held on April 7, 2026. Seats available for filing are Mayor and an Alderman in each of the three wards, all of which serve a term of two years. All candidates desiring their names on the official ballot in the election must file in person with the City Clerk at City Hall at 228 S 2^{nd} Street, Odessa, Missouri.

The opening date for candidate filing is Tuesday, December 9, 2025, at 8:00 am, and will continue during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 5:00 pm, with the closing filing date of Tuesday, December 30, 2025, at 5:00 pm. Please note that City Hall will be closed on Wednesday, December 24, and Thursday, December 25, in observance of the Christmas holiday. When Snow is in the Forecast

During a snow storm, city crews will treat the streets with sand and salt. They will normally begin around 6:00 am on the morning of or the morning after the storm. The major streets of Main, Mason, Dryden, Johnson, Phillips, First, Third, North Fourth, South Fifth, and South Ninth streets will be treated and plowed first. Other streets will be done as quickly as possible depending on the conditions. Please avoid parking vehicles on streets when snow is forecasted.

Annual Registration for Golf Carts & UTVs

A yearly permit is required to drive a golf cart or UTV within the city limits of Odessa. The annual fee for the permit is \$15.00 due at the time of registration. All permits expire on December 31. The vehicle must first be inspected by the Police Department located at 310 S First Street, between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday. You will then go to City Hall to complete the application, provide proof of insurance, and pay the fee to receive your vehicle sticker.
