Getting started is easy! Just scan the QR code below or go to https://odessa-mo.notify.daupler.com/auth to register. Enter your phone number, add the locations you want to be informed about, and view past notifications in one place.

In addition, Daupler Dispatch can be used to report utility issues that occur after hours or on holidays. If you see a power or water issue that needs to be addressed, such as a downed power pole or an active water leak, you can report the issue to the new Daupler Dispatch system by calling **816-633-5521**.



Simply follow the prompts given by the auto attendant. You may also still call City Hall at 816-230-5577 and be directed appropriately by following the automated prompts.

2025 Street Improvement Plan

The City of Odessa's 2025 Street Improvement Plan is nearly complete, featuring both chip seal maintenance and full asphalt overlay for multiple streets in Odessa. The streets completed with asphalt overlay include areas on Broken Dollar, East Marion, Hereford, Jennings, McDowell, North Russell, North Third, Opera House Ln, Rose Circle, and South Fourth, with Remington Drive and East Benning in progress.

Several streets also received chip seal maintenance to extend their lifespan and improve driving conditions, including areas on Clayton Place, Greenton Circle, Lightner Circle, Moore Place, Mt Hope, and Ozark Shortline Circle. We are as excited as you are to see these freshly improved streets across Odessa and greatly appreciate your patience as we continue to improve our community's infrastructure.

City Dog Tag Reminder

Dog tags are due October 1, 2025, and are valid from the date of purchase through September 30, 2026. All dogs within Odessa city limits are required to be licensed with the city and vaccinated against rabies. City dog tags are available for purchase at City Hall beginning October 1, 2025. The cost is \$7.00 per tag with those 65 years of age or older receiving their first dog tag free of charge. You must bring your dog's current rabies vaccination receipt to obtain a tag.
