Reminder to Apply for Your ECA Credit

In February 2026, a concern was raised regarding the calculation of the Energy Cost Adjustment (ECA) on utility bills. It was confirmed that the ordinance did not fully specify all factors used in the calculation formula, resulting in a discrepancy for a portion of the ECA. The Board of Aldermen took immediate steps to ensure the ECA calculation aligned with the corrected methodology, and updated billing began reflecting the revised calculation in February 2026.

In order to return the discrepancy portion of ECA charges to eligible customers, the City has developed a structured, voluntary credit program. The program applies to electric utility accounts active between May 2019 and January 2026. Customers are required to opt in by submitting an application and verifying account information. Credits will be calculated individually based on each customer's billing history and length of service during the affected period.

The first round of ECA credits will be reflected on this month's billing statement. This includes any credit applications received through May 20, 2026. You still have time to submit your application. We will accept applications through 5:00 pm on June 28, 2026. To apply online go to <https://www.cityofodessamo.com/news/post/10690/>. 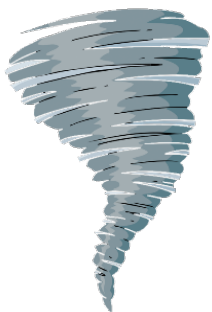

Odessa Aquatic Center is Now Open

The Odessa Aquatic Center at Dyer Park opened on Memorial Day. The daily fee is \$6 for ages 3 and over. A season pass is \$110 for an individual. The family of four season pass is \$250 for four members, with \$40 for each additional person (family members must live in the same residence to qualify).

Pool hours are 1:00-6:00 pm Monday through Thursday, Saturday and Sunday, and 1:00-7:00 pm on Friday. Pool rental is available seven days a week for pool parties.
